Margaret Mary Melville (nee Broderick) (1860-1952) Although I did not know her, I write this memorial in loving memory of my Great Grandmother, Leah Joy Bird (nee Melville). Loved wife of David Owen Melville, Mother of Will, Frank, Ted, Josephine, Leo and Eileen. Grandmother of Edward Patrick, Patricia Mary & Joan Teresa, Great Grandmother of Kevin James, Leah Joy, Yvonne Kay Melville & Paul Frances Miniken Margaret Mary Broderick was born in 1860 in Australia as the eighth child of William Broderick and Hanorah Brien. She had eight siblings, Anne, Bridget, Patrick, Michael James, John William, Hanorah, Maria Agnes, & Elizabeth Mary. The Broderick family lived in their family home "Glen Curra", Light Terrace, in the suburb of Thebarton. At 25 yrs, she married David Owen Melville, son of Alexander Melville and Catherine Travers, on 25 Apr 1885 at St Patricks Church, Thebarton, SA Witnesses to their marriage were Henry Travers & Lizzie Broderick. The family lived at 45 George Street, Norwood. She was affectionately known as Nan Melville. She died on 12 Apr 1952 (92yrs) in Maylands, SA & was buried on 15 Apr 1952 in West Terrace Cemetery Adelaide. Her brother John Broderick (1849-1903) is buried at the same site, (Old Catholic Cemetery, E5, Site 36).
