Although I did not know him I write this memorial in loving memory of my Grandfather His death occurred one month before I was born Leah Joy Bird (nee Melville) Loved husband of Elsie Nora Teresa Father of Edward Patrick, Patricia Mary & Joan Teresa Grandfather of Kevin James, Leah Joy, Yvonne Kay Melville & Paul Miniken James Edward (Ted) Melville was born on 03 Feb 1892 in Kensington, South Australia as the third child of David Owen Melville and Margaret Mary Broderick. He had five siblings, namely: William Alexander, David Francis, Mary Josephine, Eileen Gertrude, and Leo Joseph. On 12 Sep 1917 in St Ignatius Church, Norwood, he married Nora Elsie Teresa Moore, daughter of Maurice Harold Moore and Mary Hartigan, at age 25,. James Edward Melville was employed as a Motorman (MTT Tramways) between 1917–1947 in Adelaide, South Australia. He and his family were active in the Catholic community in particular the Goodwood Orphanage. Ted Melville was associated with SA football as an umpire for 26 years and retired in 1935. He umpired at league level and also fostered the game among schoolboys as an umpire and coach, in particular he was associated with the Goodwood Orphanage team and continued this in his retirement. He lived his early years with family at 46 George Street, Norwood and later with his wife and children (Edward Patrick. Patricia Mary & Joan Teresa) at 8 Third Avenue, St Morris, Adelaide, South Australia He died on 18 Nov 1947 in the Calvary Hospital, & was buried on 20 Nov 1947 in West Terrace Cemetery Adelaide. His mother-in-law, Mary Hartigan /Moore, is buried at the same site, Catholic Western Ground, Row D, Site 123)
