Mary Moore (nee Hartigan) 1856-1949 In loving memory of my great grandmother Affectionately known as "Snow" Leah Joy Bird (nee Melville). Loving wife of Maurice Harold Moore, Mother of Elsie Nora Teresa Melville, Grandmother of Edward Patrick, Patricia Mary & Joan Teresa Melville, Great grandmother of Kevin James, Leah Joy, Yvonne Kay Melville & Paul Francis Miniken. Mary Hartigan was born in 1856 in Limerick, Ireland as the first child of William Hartigan and Margaret McCarty. She had six siblings, Annie, Richard John, Margaret Theresa, Ellen Josephine, Norah Theresa, and William. Together with her parents, William & Margaret and siblings Johanna, Margaret, Richard & Ellen she immigrated to Port Adelaide, South Australia arriving on 07 Nov 1866 aboard the ship "Peeress" which had departed Plymouth on 09 Aug 1866. She married Maurice Harold Moore, son of Michael Moore and Ellen Doyle, at age 26, at St Ignatius Catholic Church, Norwood on 07 Jun 1882. They had 7 children, William Michael, Maurice Harold, Albert Thomas, Mary Margaret, Lilly Ellen, William Walter & Nora Elsie. Mary lived at 602 Military Road, Largs Bay North, South Australia and died there on 18 Jun 1949. She was buried in the same site as her son-in-law James Edward Melville on 20 Jun 1949 in West Terrace Cemetery Adelaide (Catholic Western Ground, Row D, Site 123). Her husband Maurice Harold Moore (1853-1909) is buried in next grave (Catholic Western Ground, Row D, Site 122)
