Maurice Harold Moore (1853-1909) In loving memory of my Great Grandfather Maurice Harold Moore Leah Joy Bird (nee Melville). Maurice Harold Moore was born in 1853 in Limerick, Ireland as the second child of Michael Moore and Ellen Doyle. He had four siblings, Mary, Terence, James, and Ellen. At 14 years of age he immigrated from Limerick, Ireland to Port Adelaide, SA on 14 Jul 1866, aboard the ship "British Lion". He married Mary Hartigan, daughter of William Hartigan and Margaret McCarty, on 07 Jun 1882, in St Ignatius Church, Norwood. Maurice Harold Moore was a drover in his early years & later employed as a Tram Driver with M.T.T. The family lived at Childers Street, North Adelaide, SA. He died at his residence in Childers Street on 4 Nov 1909 & was buried on 05 Sep in West Terrace Cemetery Adelaide, (Catholic Western, Row D Site 122). His wife Mary & their son-in-law, James Edward Melville, are buried in the grave next to him (Site 123).
