WEST TERRACE CEMETERY BY NIGHT VISITOR INFORMATION

LOCATION: Your tour guide will meet you outside the little redbrick house just inside the main entrance to the cemetery. Please meet 10 to 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.

DURATION: The West Terrace Cemetery By Night guided tour is one hour in duration. It involves approximately 1.5 kilometres of walking over relatively flat terrain.

SUITABILITY: The special effects, storytelling and atmosphere of the West Terrace Cemetery By Night tour creates a fantastic atmosphere. However, some people, especially young children may find it a little unnerving.

This tour may not be suitable for children aged 12 years and under. The appropriateness of the tour is dependent on the age and 'stage' of your child. If your child is very young, very active and tends to suffer with nightmares, then this tour may not be suitable. All persons under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.

Visitors with a disability are strongly encouraged to speak to staff. Night tours pose significant challenges for anyone with mobility restrictions. The tour involves approximately 1.5 kilometres of walking, often in low light levels, and over slightly uneven terrain. Unfortunately only 80% of our tour is accessible by wheelchair.

DRESS: The tour takes place outside so please dress for the conditions. Warm and comfortable clothing is recommended along with sturdy closed toe shoes (no high heels). If rain has been forecast, a raincoat and umbrella are advised.

FITNESS LEVEL: A basic level of fitness is required. The tour involves approximately 1.5 kilometres of walking over relatively flat terrain at an even pace. However, in some areas you may encounter slightly uneven surfaces underfoot.



SMOKING & ALCOHOL:	Smoking and alcohol are not permitted on the night tours and people under the the influence of alcohol will not be allowed to participate in the tour.
VEHICLE ACCESS:	The cemetery can be accessed via the main entrance at the intersection of Sturt Street and West Terrace. If you are travelling southbound along West Terrace your ability to turn right into the cemetery is restricted between 4pm and 10am.
PARKING:	Limited parking is available onsite. As you enter the cemetery, turn to your left and park to the side of the roadway. Alternate parking is available on Sturt Street and Wylde Road. If unsure, please seek assistance from staff.
TOILETS:	Male, female and disabled toilets are located just inside the main entrance to the cemetery. It is advisable that you use these facilities prior to the commencement of the tour as they are the only toilet facilities at the cemetery.
FILMING & PHOTOGRAPHY:	Cameras that take still photographs are allowed, however flash photography is not permitted. Video cameras are also prohibited.
PAYMENT:	Payment is required on the night, unless alternate arrangements have been made when placing your booking. Payment must be made by cash as there are no eftpos or credit card facilities at West Terrace Cemetery.
CONCESSION:	Concession rates are available for holders of valid and current concession cards. All concession cards must be presented at the time of payment to be eligible for concession prices. Accepted concession cards include: Seniors Card, Pensioner Card and Student Card. Any adult seeking a concession must be the main beneficiary of the concession card. Concession rates are also available for group bookings of 10 or more.
CANCELLATION:	A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required. If inclement weather is forecast for the scheduled tour date you will be contacted by the Adelaide Cemeteries Authority to discuss your arrangements. A minimum of 12 people is required for each scheduled tour to go ahead.
