

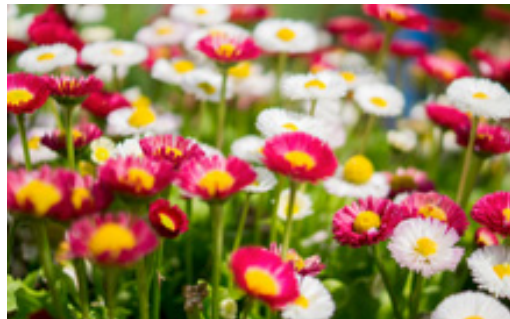

Eulogy for Richard Clayton Helps As written by his wife Joy Helps on 24th September 2013 Clayton was born at the home of his paternal grandmother at Collinswood to Ivan (know as Dick) and Dorothy Helps on the 27th Dec 1930. Clayton grew up in Maylands and went to the Church Of Christ; he was educated at Wellington Road, Primary School and Norwood Boys Technical School. Clayton studied for Accounting but never finished, he then went on to work as a sales representative and sales manager – at Bear Manning, Monier Besser, James Hardie and Bedford Industries.
